This is an exciting addition to our annual exhibition offering an opportunity for every member of VAS to have work included in the exhibition, with a fantastic varied selection of small works for sale at affordable prices.

All VAS members are welcome to submit work. There is no selection process - so no need to send images or details of your work prior to delivery and there is no entry charge. Throughout the exhibition, works will be rotated on show in browsers and a wall display.

# EACH ARTIST MAY SUBMIT:

**Up to three** unframed works mounted on a  $30 \times 30$  cm board (The work itself can be smaller but must fit within  $30 \times 30$  cm)

## OR

**Up to three 3D objects** that are suitable to stand securely on a shelf 7 cm deep, and with a maximum height of 25cm. (sculptural/craft objects only please, not paintings in frames or on canvasses)

## SUBMISSION DETAILS:

• Labelling

All works must be clearly labelled on the back of the work with the following:

Artist Title Media Price

• Presentation

2D works must be 30 x 30cm, or smaller works must be mounted on 30 x 30cm

mount board. Works should be wrapped neatly in a single layer of clear cellophane for protection. Work not presented as requested will not be accepted.

• Pricing

We are setting a maximum price of £300 for each work, with sales commission of 40% being applied on the sale price of all work sold.

The society accepts no responsibility for works lost or damaged in the post, or for underpaid postage.

• Liability for Works

The SSA & VAS will endeavour to take care of all works submitted. Unframed works in mounts will be cellophane wrapped by the societies to protect them from damage, however, the societies do not hold themselves responsible for any loss or damage which may occur to works while in the custody of the Societies or their agents. The Societies do not insure work in transit or while in the Gallery, we recommend that you take out your own artists insurance if it is required.

## Uncollected Artworks

Any work not collected by owner or agent on the dates above or any works that arrive without return postage and packaging will become property of VAS and will be resold or disposed of as appropriate.
